

Georgia EPD Proposes Revisions to the Air Permit Fees

EPD is proposing to revise the Air Permit Fee structure in order to make up for their anticipated revenue shortfall beginning in 2020. The revenue shortfall was caused by the retirement of several large facilities which caused a revenue shortfall of approximately \$2.2 million per year. While emissions through the state have decreased significantly, EPD's workload has not.

The goal of the proposed changes is to create stability of funding for the delegated permitting program and ensure that the future funding properly reflects the changing workload in the Air Protection Branch. Currently, Title V sources are paying disproportionately more than minor and synthetic sources for the time and cost expended by EPD. Georgia EPD evaluated strategies used in other states in the Southeastern U.S. and has developed this proposed rule change.

The permit application fees, expedited permit fees, and emission fees will all be impacted by the proposed changes as documented below.

Timeline:

The comment period for this rule will take place in March – April 2020. If no changes are proposed to the rule, this will take effect on July 1, 2020. This will affect the annual emission fees due in September 2020 and permit application fees due beginning March 1, 2021.
